## ***OUR VALUES***

The University of Bari “Aldo Moro,” established in 1925 from the ancient Schools of Pharmacy and Notary, has come a long way to enter the 10 Italian states’ “mega” universities.

This is thanks to an undoubtedly rich educational offer, the numerous services offered to students, the focus on teaching and research, and, undoubtedly, the third mission.

As written in our Statute, the University Community pursues, as its primary purpose, research and training to develop critical knowledge, be open to dialogue and interaction between cultures, respect freedom of research and teaching, be sustainable, and enhance merit.

The student is the heart of the University institution, and each project is designed to make Uniba increasingly inclusive and welcoming.

Most of the courses are taught in Italian, but we are expanding our educational offer in English: We have a bachelor's degree in Earth Systems and Global Changes, as well as master's degrees in Computer science, Innovation development in agri-food systems (IDEAS), Materials Science and Technology, Physics, and the single-cycle course in Medicine and Surgery, as well as other courses of study, such as I and II level Master's degrees.



## **RECEPTION AND ENTRY PROCEDURES**

Some bureaucratic procedures and the issuance of essential documents are necessary for living and travelling in Italian territory. Primarily, find out which category of student you belong to ([link](#))

EU citizens and non-EU citizens with EU equivalent status need neither to pre-enroll nor take the Italian language test, and they are included in the rankings of Italian students for the entrance tests. Those who intend to stay in Italy for over three months must register at the Municipality of residence. Before leaving your country, check the validity and expiration of your ID or passport!

Non-EU citizens residing abroad: An entry visa for study purposes is required to enroll in Italian universities.

The visa must be requested by pre-enrolling on the University platform: [www.universitaly.it](http://www.universitaly.it)  
For enrolment in degree courses taught in Italian, it is mandatory to submit an Italian Language Certificate of Proficiency with a grade not below the B2 level and as determined by the CLIQ. Alternatively, candidates must take the Italian language test at Uniba with CLA. For courses with restricted access, non-EU citizens residing abroad are included in reserved rankings.



## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

To enroll in **Bachelor's and Single-Cycle degree courses**, you will need a high school diploma obtained after at least 12 years of studies, which enables admission to a first-level University degree under the laws of the Country of issuance.

To enroll in **Master's degree courses**, you will need to have a University-level qualification, achieved after no fewer than 15 years of studies, of which at least three at the University level, enabling admission to a second-level University degree under the laws of the Country of issuance, together with the specific curricular requirements present on the web pages of the various courses.

## **UNIVERSITY LANGUAGE CENTER (CLA)**

The CLA (University Language Center) is a member of the Italian Association of University Language Centers (AICLU) and an authorized examination center for international language certifications.





## ***SPORT***

The University Sports Centre (CUS) of Bari, recognized by CONI (Italian National Olympic Committee), promotes sports policy in the university environment within the framework of the student's overall education. In addition to the management and maintenance of sports facilities, the Center promotes initiation or specialization courses in the various disciplines and participates in university and federal competitive activities. It offers the opportunity to practice sports such as athletics, basketball, football, canoeing, rowing, cross training, fitness, karate, Olympic wrestling, swimming, volleyball, skating, triathlon...

## ***ORIENTATION SERVICE AND EURODESK***

Orientation service accompanies students in their study path during their incoming, ongoing and outgoing activities. The Eurodesk Local Agency at Uniba offers free information, promotion and orientation services on European transnational mobility programs for young people, with the primary objective of facilitating young people's access to mobility opportunities in the field of study, work, training and volunteering to acquire new skills and personal skills through experiences abroad.

## ***LIBRARIES***

Uniba's libraries and archives system includes libraries and reading rooms equipped with Wi-Fi for extended hours.

## ***PLACEMENT AGENCY***

The Placement Agency fosters and promotes students' and graduates' entry into the labor market, providing them with the tools to cope with the transition from university to the world of work. In addition, the web Application PORTIAMO VALORE connects Institutions and Companies with undergraduates and graduates.



## ***INTERUNIVERSITY RESEARCH CENTRE FOR THEATRE, VISUAL ARTS, MUSIC AND CINEMA***

The Centre aims at fruitful action in the variegated metropolitan scenario, based on the principles of inclusive citizenship and intercultural dialogue. In this sense, it supports the university world's involvement (also in an educational function) in the scientific experience, the comparison of ideas, and the initiative.

## ***INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS UNIT***

The International Students Unit takes care of the entire management of international students, from the pre-evaluation of qualifications before their arrival to the validation of the application for admission to the university to assistance once in Bari. The Unit supports the student in carrying out some procedures needed to be implemented upon their arrival in Italy, including:

1. the request of the tax code to the Agenzia delle Entrate (Revenue Agency);
2. indications about the application for a residence permit and subsequent renewal.
3. assistance in applying for ISEE and equalized ISEE (respectively for incomes produced in Italy or abroad) at affiliated CAFs;
4. support for the request for scholarships to Adisu, the Regional Authority for the Right to Education;
5. guidance for opening a bank account and much more.

## ***DISABILITY AND SLD UNIT***

The Services to Disabled Students and SLD Unit guarantees, through the activation of specific services, the protection and support of the right to study in the presence of disabilities and Specific Learning Disorder (SLD) and full inclusion in university life, in compliance with Law 17/99 which integrates the previous Law 104/92 and Law 170/2010. The office is available to provide specific and/or individual services and any study aids.

## ***TUTORING SERVICE- BUDDY STUDENTS***

The service was created to provide international students with a system of reception and assistance. Students who start their path will be supported by regularly enrolled Uniba students with adequate language skills in peer-to-peer tutoring logic.



## ***STUDENT COLLABORATIONS - 150 HOURS (PART-TIME)***

Student collaboration is an opportunity offered to students to carry out part-time collaboration activities at various university facilities, such as libraries, laboratories, museums, administrative services, etc., in the university's headquarters (Bari- Brindisi-Taranto). The collaboration has a maximum duration of 150 hours for each academic year and is remunerated with an hourly fee determined in the annual call.

## ***SERVICES AND PROVISIONS FOR STUDENTS***

Uniba offers the possibility of providing an extraordinary financial subsidy to valuable students with financial difficulties that hinder or compromise the regular continuation of their studies.

## ***CAP***

CAP (lifelong learning center) promotes lifelong learning processes, certification and accreditation of skills acquired in formal and informal contexts. Among its activities: preliminary work and consultancy for the request for finalized recognition of formal qualifications and partial recognition of individual training credits, recognition of learning acquired "on the job" in informal and non-formal contexts to start the recognition procedure of professional qualifications, evaluation and certification of soft skills.





## **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Uniba provides some specific scholarships for international students, such as the call for 25 annual scholarships for international students residing abroad enrolling in degree programs at the University of Bari Aldo Moro in the academic year 2024/2025 ([link](#)) or University Corridors for Refugees – UNICORE.
